

Resolution Regarding Faculty Commitment to Student Success and Well-Being

WHEREAS

The faculty of Illinois Tech recognize that the university is undergoing a period of severe institutional crisis, marked by a large budget deficit and sudden and extensive faculty reductions;

WHEREAS

These disruptions have created widespread uncertainty and anxiety regarding the continuity and quality of academic programs, mentorship, and student support services;

WHEREAS

The Senate has expressed grave concern regarding the administrative governance and operational direction of the institution; and

WHEREAS

The fundamental purpose of Illinois Tech remains the education, intellectual growth, and well-being of its student body;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Senate reaffirms, in the strongest possible terms, the faculty's primary and unyielding commitment to the academic success, mental health, and overall well-being of all undergraduate and graduate students.
2. The faculty pledges to take all reasonable and achievable steps to minimize the impact of structural changes on degree completion, course availability, thesis supervision, and academic advising.
3. The Senate calls upon all academic departments to establish open forums and provide whatever office hours and dedicated check-ins to ensure students have a clear, transparent space to voice concerns and receive guidance.
4. The Senate commits to prioritizing student-centered advocacy in all future governance discussions, ensuring that remaining institutional resources are directed toward preserving the core educational mission.
