

Resolution of No Confidence in the President, Provost, CFO, and Head of Advancement

Whereas: The President, Provost, CFO, and Head of Advancement, of the Illinois Institute of Technology, have consistently ignored the principles of shared governance of the university, as required by the university faculty handbook, and,

Whereas: The lack of shared governance has substantially caused the current university financial crisis,

Therefore, be it resolved that: By vote of the Faculty Senate, it is determined that the faculty of the university have no confidence that this administration, as led by the President, Provost, CFO, and Head of Advancement, can define and implement a plan to resolve the crisis, improve the stability of the university, and re-establish the conditions for the faculty to fulfill the mission of the university for the benefit of its students.
