

Resolution Regarding Faculty Commitment to Student Success and Well-Being

August 5, 2026

WHEREAS

The faculty of Illinois Tech recognize that the university is undergoing a period of severe institutional crisis, marked by a large budget deficit and sudden and extensive faculty reductions;

WHEREAS

These disruptions have created widespread uncertainty and anxiety regarding the continuity, quality, and accreditability of academic programs, mentorship, scheduling, financial aid, and student support services;

WHEREAS

Incoming and early to mid stage students are doubting whether they can continue at Illinois Tech under current circumstances;

WHEREAS The Senate has expressed grave concern regarding the administrative governance and operational direction of the institution; and

WHEREAS The fundamental purpose of Illinois Tech remains the education, intellectual growth, and well-being of its student body;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT

1. The Senate reaffirms, in the strongest possible terms, the faculty's primary and unyielding commitment to the academic success, mental health, and overall well-being of all undergraduate and graduate students.
2. The Senate calls for full administrative transparency for all current and incoming students.
